(U) Key Updates

(U//FOUO) A summary of new significant information from the previous SITREP.

- As of this update, SE Command Post is aware of at least 27 protests planned for 6/5, times and locations identified below.
- Overnight SOMEX trend analysis purported demonstrators self-policing against agitators, including Anarchist actors.
- Numerous reporting of the use of green laser pointers targeting G1 and Police Officers.

Spokane RA

- Multiple unconfirmed reports from various sources indicate that protesters, possibly including Antifa, are traveling to Spokane to foment violence during protests this weekend, 6/6-7.
- "Proud boys" and "3%ers" will be present during the 6/7 BLM protests, in civilian clothes. [Note: "Proud Boys" consider themselves a patriotic fraternity. All races are represented within the "Proud Boys".]

- (U//FOUO) SPD is facing staffing challenges and has requested additional resources to relieve officers.
