- (U) *The New York Times* published an [online article](#) about the Pierce County Medical Examiner's Office conclusion that Manuel Ellis's death on 3 March was a homicide. Local news coverage—both print and television—have picked up the story, and Governor Inslee made a statement about Ellis's death.

- The theme found on SOMEX within the Seattle AOR for the overnight hours of 3 June 2020 to 4 June 2020 was of positive of continued de-escalation of tensions with police and the rejection of violent methods and actors. No chatter of violent tactics or actions. However, there were reminders not to conduct such conversations over non-secure social media.
- Multiple Twitter postings discussing the use of passive tactical techniques used by the Hong Kong protesters and adaptation for use the current protest environment. Posting provided links to videos, and internet articles and encouraged views to conduct their own research.
