This to inform you that at your request, the U.S. Board on Geographic Names (BGN) agreed to revisit its May 2016 decision not to approve the new name Mount Carl Brady for an unnamed summit in the Chugach National Forest. However, at its October 12, 2017 meeting, the BGN did not approve the proposal, citing the negative recommendations of the U.S. Forest Service as well as the Chugach Alaska Corporation, the Native Village of Eyak, Sealaska Heritage, and the Eyak Corporation.
