MANDELA HAS BEEN ACCORDED OFFICIAL STATUS AS AN OFFICIAL GUEST OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT. THIS STATUS ALLOWS MANDELA'S VISIT TO FALL WITHIN THE PURVIEW OF THE PRO STATUTE. THE US DEPARTMENT OF STATE WILL HAVE THE OVERALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR MANDELA'S SECURITY. THE UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE WILL NOT BE INVOLVED IN MANDELA'S SECURITY. THE PURPOSE OF MANDELA'S VISIT IS TO STAGE A PUBLIC MEDIA EVENT. MANDELA WILL BE CONDUCTING A FUND RAISER AS WELL AS EXPRESSING HIS GRATITUDE TO THE MAJOR CORPORATIONS AND UNIONS WHO SUPPORT HIS ANTI-APARTHEID STANDE.

MANDELA'S TRAVEL ITINERARY TO DATE IS AS FOLLOWS:

JUNE 20 TO THE 23RD, 1990. NEW YORK CITY; JUNE 23RD. BOSTON; JUNE 24TH THROUGH THE 26TH. WASHINGTON D.C.; JUNE 27TH, ATLANTA AND MIAMI; JUNE 28TH, DETROIT; JUNE 29TH THROUGH THE 30TH, LOS ANGELES. A DETAILED ITINERARY OF MANDELA'S VISIT WILL BE FORWARDED TO THE BUREAU AND RECEIVING OFFICES AS SOON AS IT BECOME AVAILABLE.

THE BUREAU IS BEING DESIGNATED OFFICE OF ORIGIN IN CAPTIONED CASE INASMUCH AS MANDELA WILL BE TRAVELING THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES ON A SEVEN (7) CITY TOUR. ANY AND ALL THREAT INFORMATION

Mr. MANDELA is now expected to arrive in Miami
on the evening of 6/27/90 or early morning 6/28/90. Should
his arrival occur on the 27th, he and his wife will stay
overnight at the ALEXANDER HOTEL, 5225 Collins Avenue,
Miami Beach, Florida.

On the morning of 6/28/90, Mr. MANDELA is scheduled
to deliver a speech to the AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE,
COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES (AFSCME) at the MIAMI BEACH
CONVENTION CENTER. Following this engagement he is expected
to motorcade to MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT where he will
board a flight for Detroit, Michigan.

Security during Mr. MANDELA's visit is being
furnished by the U. S. Department of State (DOS). DOS
representatives have classified the threat level for this
visit as "high," and threats to harm Mr. MANDELA have been

that MANDELA would be assassinated "either in Atlanta or
