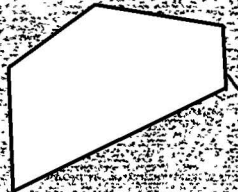

MANDI A WILL THEN PROCEED TO THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE SCLC FOR A CONFERENCE WITH THE REVEREND JOSEPH LOWERY AND OTHER PROMINENT SCLC LEADERS.

FROM THERE, MANDELA WILL PROCEED TO THE BIG BETHEL AME CHURCH FOR UNDISCLOSED MEETINGS/CEREMONIES, LASTING FROM APPROXIMATELY 11:15 A.M. - 12:15 P.M.

MANDELA WILL THEN ATTEND A \$1,000.00 PER PLATE LUNCHEON IN HIS HONOR TO BE HELD AT THE JIMMY CARTER PRESIDENTIAL CENTER.

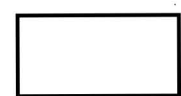

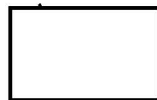

Mandelas' California Itinerary

South African black liberation leader Nelson Mandela, his wife, Winnie, and a 15-member delegation from the African National Congress begin their two-day California visit tomorrow.

After arriving at about 10:30 a.m., Mandela will be shuttled by motorcade from the Los Angeles International Airport to City Hall, where he will be greeted by Mayor Tom Bradley. Mandela will meet members of the City Council in a closed session. At about 12:30 p.m., he is scheduled to join a rally and public welcoming ceremony on the steps of City Hall.

His evening itinerary includes a fund-raising reception and dinner at 6 p.m. at the Museum of Science and Industry. He also will attend a rally at the nearby Los Angeles Coliseum, where he is scheduled to speak at about 10 p.m.

Mandela will spend the night in Los Angeles and then board a plane at about 9:30 a.m. for Oakland, the last stop on his six-week international tour. The anti-apartheid leader will be driven to the Hyatt Regency Hotel for a brief rest.

A rally and musical tribute at the Oakland Coliseum will begin at noon. At about 2:30 p.m., Mandela is expected to address the sold-out crowd of 58,000 in a 25- to 30-minute speech. A reception with Winnie Mandela will begin at 4 p.m. at the Berkeley Community Theater.

A gala dinner for the Mandelas will begin at 6 p.m. at the Oakland Convention Center. The banquet will be followed by a private reception at A.J. Toppers restaurant atop the Hyatt Regency for about 200 people

who contributed \$2,500 or more to the ANC.

Before the coliseum rally and hotel dinner, State Department security agents will use dogs and metal detectors to sweep both areas for explosives and weapons. The metal detectors also will be used to scan people attending both events. The Mandelas are scheduled to leave Oakland on Sunday between 9 a.m. and noon.

ANC Delegate To Meet With Unions

A delegate of the African National Congress traveling with Nelson Mandela will meet with members of the California Labor Federation in an attempt to strengthen ties between labor unions in South Africa and the Bay Area.

The federation requested the meeting with Chris Dlamini, head of the Congress of South African Trade Unions, to develop "a program of concerted action between the two union movements and start working for what will ultimately be the last leg of liberation of South Africa," said ironworker Frank Pottier, who organized the event.

Pottier said representatives for most of the unions in Northern California are expected to attend the event, which will start at 4 p.m. at Local 6 of the International Longshoremens and Warehousemen's Union on Hegenberger Road in Oakland.

"The first thing is to work effectively on the sanctions and even increase them if necessary," Pottier said. "As American trade unions, we feel we can help in many ways. We will ask him what he wants, and if it's money he needs, he'll get it."

Black trade unions had been banned in South African for nearly 30 years until February, when the government released Mandela from prison.

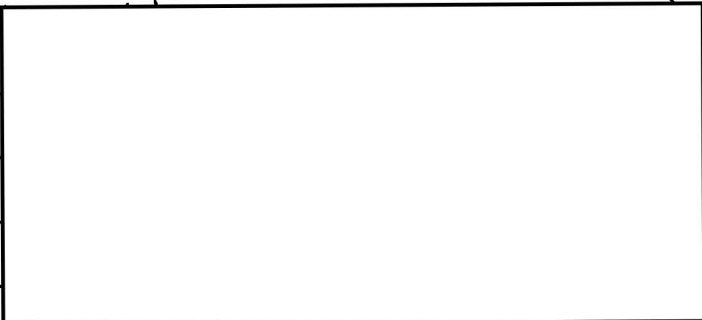

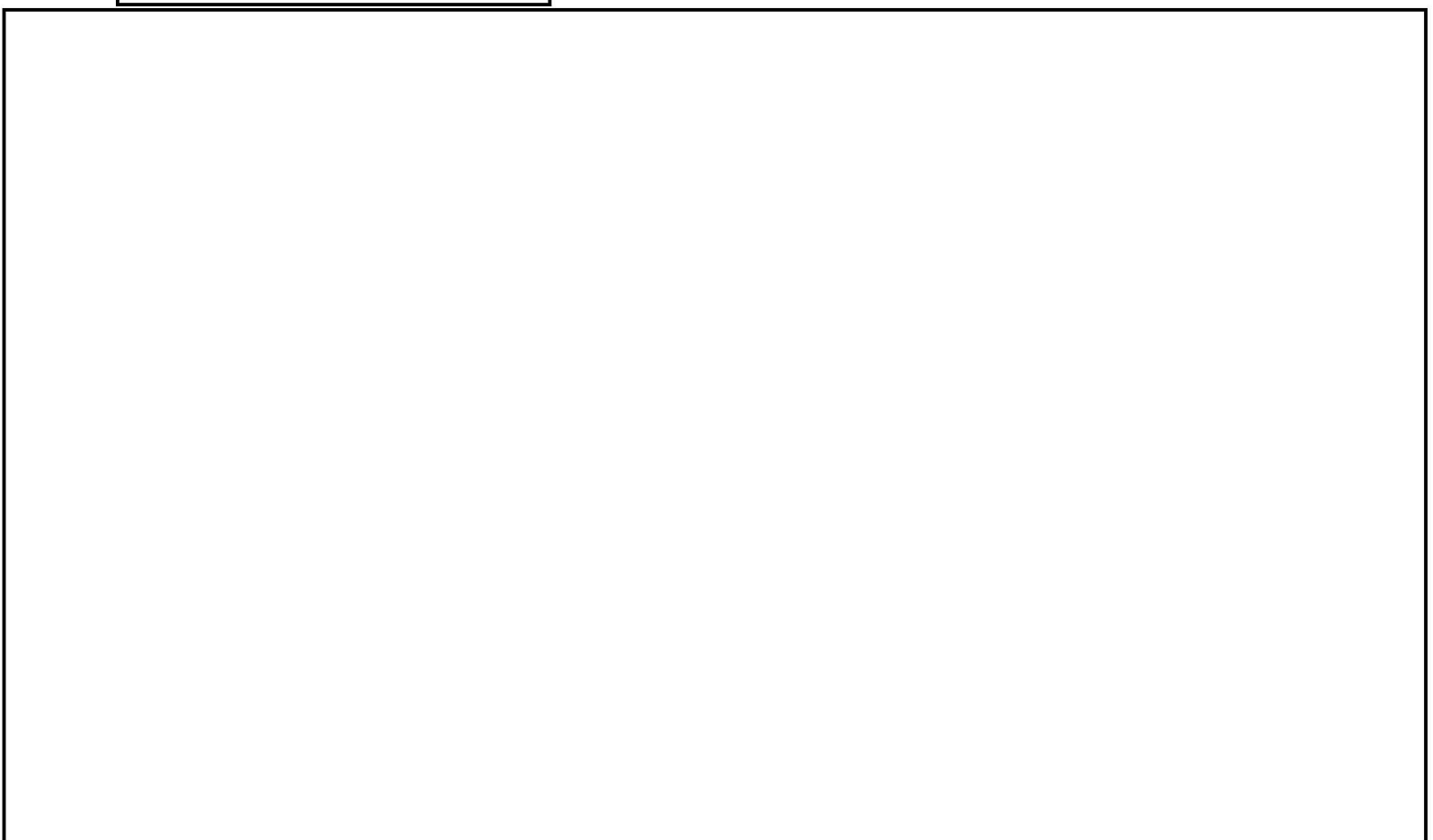

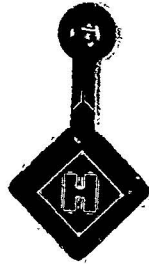

TEMPORARY IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM for the Visit of Nelson Mandela to the Cities of San Francisco and Oakland



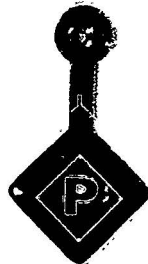
