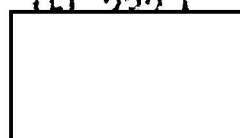

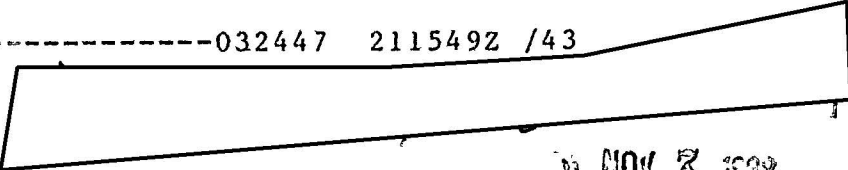

1. SUMMARY. THIRD COMMITTEE DEBATE ON RACISM, SELF-
DETERMINATION, AND ASSISTANCE TO SOUTH AFRICA (AGENDA
ITEMS NUMBER 87, 88, 91, 96) WAS ROUTINE AND PREDICT-
ABLE. THE ONLY EXPLICIT CRITICISMS OF THE U.S. WERE
ZIMBABWE'S REFERENCE TO U.S. SUPPORT FOR "BANDITS" IN
ANGOLA AND CUBA'S RITUALISTIC BUT LOW-KEY DENUNCIATIONS.
THE U.S. STATEMENT (OCTOBER 14) EMPHASIZED OUR OPPOSTI-
TION TO RACISM AND APARTHEID. IN ADDITION, THE U.S.
REPRESENTATIVE INDICATED THAT THE U.S. WILL SHIFT ITS
INITIATIVE ON THE PRINCIPLE OF PERIODIC AND GENUINE
ELECTIONS FROM THE AGENDA ITEM ON SELF-DETERMINATION TO
SOME OTHER ITEM. END SUMMARY.

2. DURING OCT. 10-19 MEETINGS, THE UNGA'S THIRD COM-
MITTEE DEBATED THE FOLLOWING TOPICS:

4. IN HER OCTOBER 14 STATEMENT (SEPTEL), AMBASSADOR
~~PATRICIA M. BYRNE~~, ALTERNATE U.S. REPRESENTATIVE TO THE
43RD GA, STATED THAT THE HISTORY AND RECORD OF THE U.S.
CLEARLY DEMONSTRATE OUR ABHORRENCE FOR RACISM, RACIAL
DISCRIMINATION, AND APARTHEID. IN THE INTERNATIONAL
CONTEXT, SHE SAID, THE UNITED STATES IS WORKING TOWARD
BRINGING AN END TO THE RACIST SYSTEM OF APARTHEID IN
SOUTH AFRICA. IN ADDITION, AMBASSADOR BYRNE INDICATED,
THE U.S. SUPPORTS THE RELEASE OF ~~NELSON MANDELA~~ AND ALL
OTHER POLITICAL PRISONERS, AND HAS CALLED FOR AN END TO
