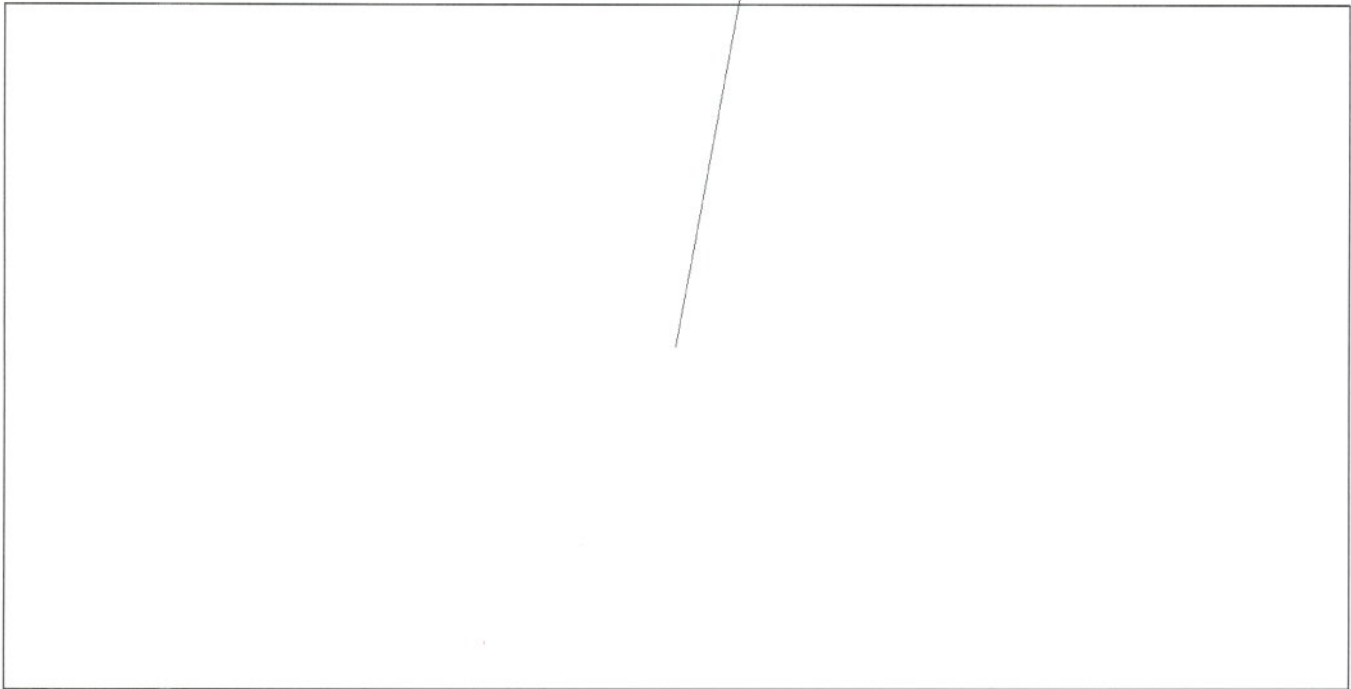


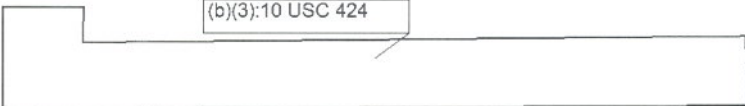

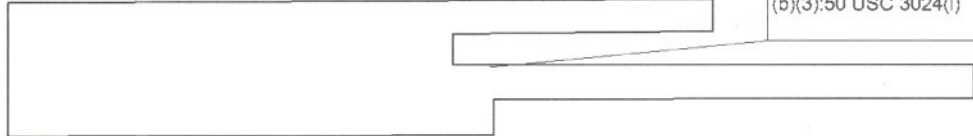

GREENHAM IS APPARENTLY A CAREER DIPLOMAT, AND PREVIOUSLY SERVED AS A POLITICAL OFFICER IN THE SOUTH AFRICAN EMBASSY IN TEL AVIV BETWEEN ABOUT 830000 AND 880000. FROM ABOUT 880000 TO 930000, GREENHAM LEFT THE FOREIGN SERVICE, AND STUDIED RELIGION AT A BAPTIST COLLEGE IN DALLAS , TEXAS.
