SUMMARY: (C) GHANA FEELS SOUTH AFRICA SHOULD AND WILL SHOULD THE BURDEN OF A PEACEKEEPING FORCE IN BURUNDI. GHANA WILL CONTRIBUTE TO THE FORCE IF THERE IS PEACE IN BURUNDI AND THE UNITED NATIONS PROVIDES A MANDATE.

TEXT: 1. (C) MINISTER FOR DEFENSE DR. KWAME ((ADDO-KUFUOR)) COMPLETED TWO TRIPS IN THE PAST TWO WEEKS RELATED TO THE BURUNDI PEACE PROCESS. THE FIRST TRIP WAS TO ARUSHA, TANZANIA. THE SECOND WAS TO PRETORIA, SOUTH AFRICA. ADDO-KUFUOR WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THE MINISTRY'S CHIEF DIRECTOR, FRANK ((MPARE)), AND BY THE MINISTER'S MILITARY ASSISTANT, LIEUTENANT COLONEL O.B. ((AKWA)).

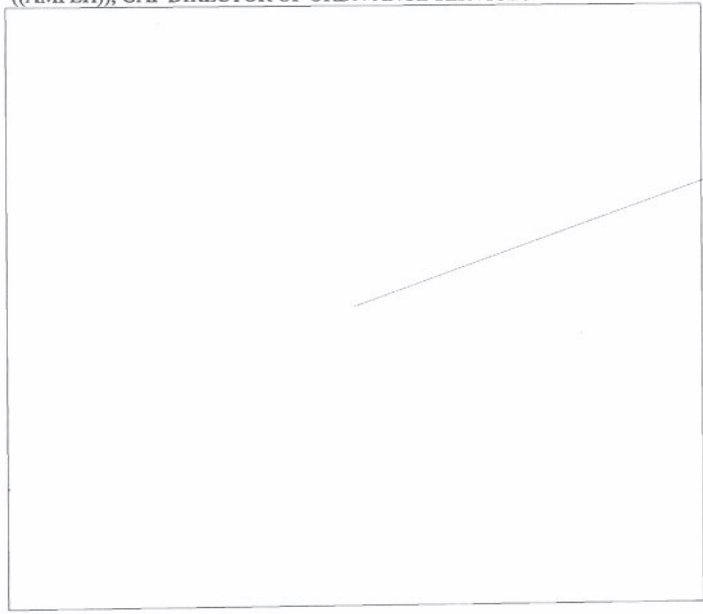
